Women's College, a dynamically growing institute with nearly 4000 students and 54 faculties; has also maintained an exceptional reputation as, a result oriented and dependable institute synergizing towards the goal of women empowerment in this patriarchal society. It is re-accredited B Grade with 2.61 points by last NAAC visit in the year 2016.

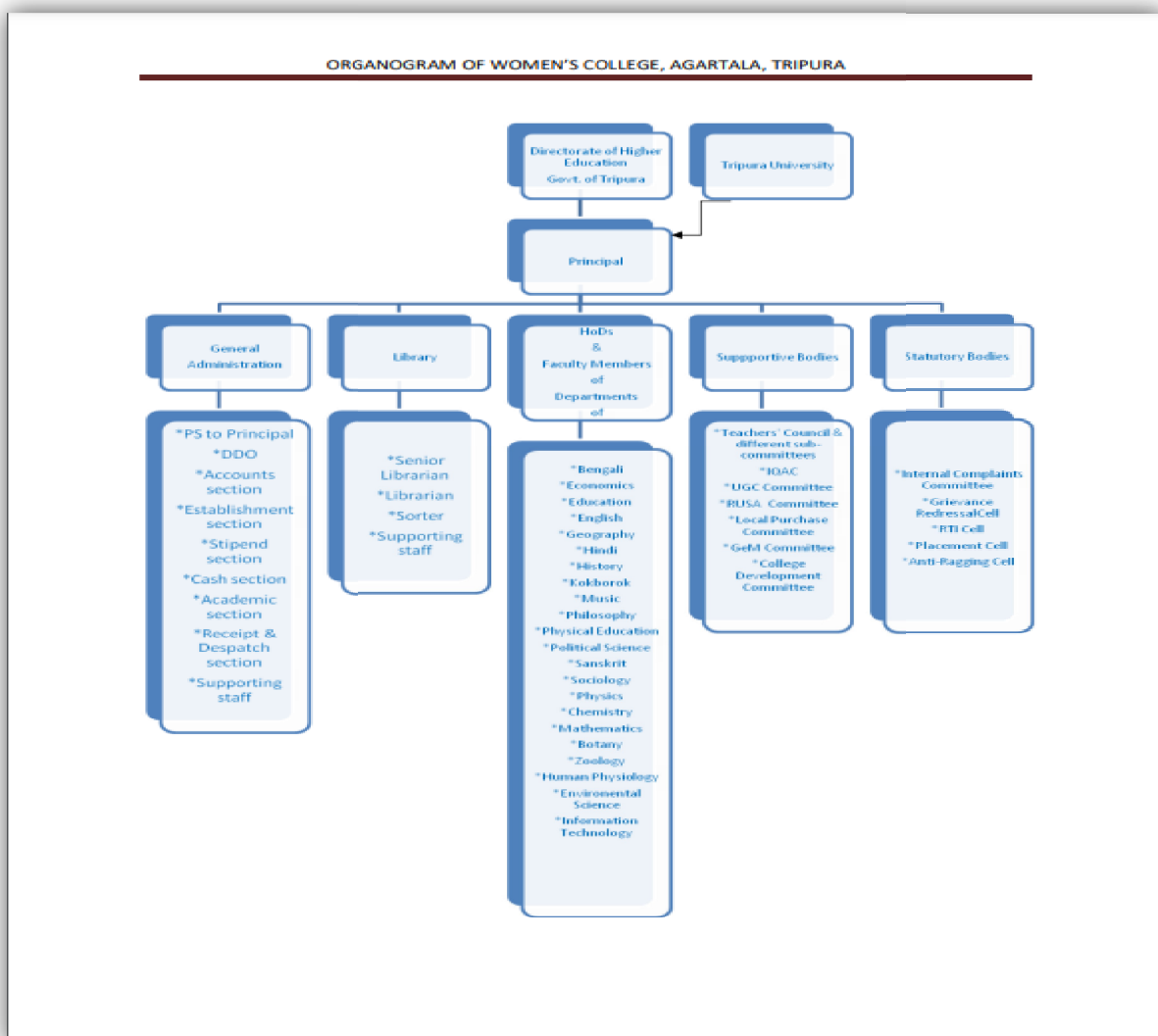
## OUR MISSION

## **ACADEMICS**

As Women's college envisions to effectively execute the teaching learning procedure, an academic calendar is prepared as per the parent University's academic schedule. The institution adheres to the academic calendar in preparing the schedules of classes, conducting different events, as well as the conduct of Continuous Internal Evaluation. The present academic session faced several changes because of the pandemic situation. The odd semester (I, III, IV) online classes started from November, 2020 followed by their internal examination during February 2021. The end semester examination for 1<sup>st</sup>, 3<sup>rd</sup> and 5<sup>th</sup> semester commenced during March, 2021. The even semester classes started from June, 2021 and their internal examination started from August, 2021 followed by end semester examination during September, 2021. Again, the odd semester classes started during October followed by their internal examination during December, 2021. Both online and offline mode of examination was followed this year.

## **STUDENTS' COUNCIL**

The Students' Council of the college is an elected body of student representatives. It functions in close association with the rest of the college units i.e. administration, teaching and non-teaching staff and students for smooth functioning of the college. The Students' Council brings forth the concerns of students before the college authorities from time to time so that problems may be resolved smoothly and in an appropriate manner. The Students' Council is actively engaged in various academic, administrative and cultural activities in the college throughout the year.



## **ALUMNI ASSOCIATION**

Women's College, Agartala has a registered alumni association with registration number 4431 dated 20<sup>th</sup> May, 2004. The Office of the alumni association comprises of the President, Secretary, Joint Secretary, Treasurer and executive members chosen from among the members of the association. The objectives of the Association is to render all round help for the development of Women's College, to build up unity among the ex-students of Women's College, Agartala for the development of the society and also to organize, undertake, cooperate in the social services, activities and projects. Keeping all these objectives in view, Alumni Association of Women's College is relentlessly working to provide service to the community.

## **INFRASTRUCTURE**

The college is now having 37 classrooms, 03 ICT enabled smart classrooms, a library with a separate reading room facility, laboratories for all science departments and Geography. The college has separate rooms for NCC and NSS. In the administrative building of the college, there are Academic Section, Receive and Despatch Section, Stipend Section, office of the DDO and the Principal. The college has a separate Examination Cell, IQAC Cell and a Conference room. There is a big common Staffroom for the faculties with a computer, printer and internet facility. The college has also a well equipped modern gymnasium. There is a computer laboratory with 38 computers. Recently the college is equipped with ramps, railings, lifts and all other facilities for the visually and physically impaired students.

## **STUDENTS' ADMISSION**

The admission to the three years degree programme of all General Degree Colleges of the state is conducted through online mode under the guidelines of the Directorate of Higher Education, Government of Tripura. Women's College, being one of the General Degree College of the State follows the same guidelines as framed by the Directorate of Higher Education. The eligibility criteria for seeking admission to the college are decided according to the rules and regulation framed by the affiliating university, i.e Tripura University. Women's College being the only college specifically for girls in the entire state, the demand to get admission to this college by the aspiring girl students is very prominent. The College offers admission to 17 Honours Courses and 21 General Courses. The Courses includes the Subject of Bengali, English, Economics,

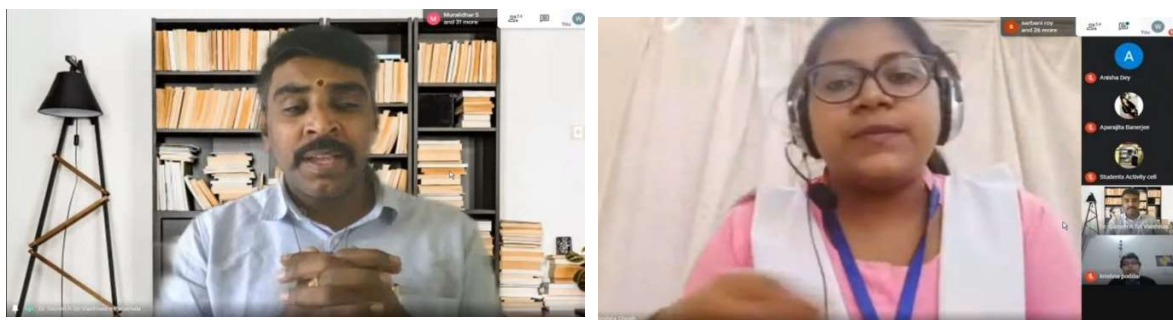
Education, Geography, History, Hindi, Political Science, Philosophy, Sanskrit, Sociology, Chemistry, Maths, Physics, Botany, Human Physiology, Zoology, Kokborok, Music, Physical Education and Environmental Science. The admission process of General Degree College is conducted and completed through four phases. The first three phases are conducted purely through online mode and the fourth phase is conducted through offline mode. The aspiring students wishing to take admission to the college have to fill a combined online application form through the Online Application Portal Link provided in the website of the Directorate of Higher Education, wherein the candidates are given the choice to choose their preferred college as well as their preferred subject. A time frame is provided for all the applicants to apply as per their desired choices and then the merit list is published along with the waiting list. The admission to the college by the students is then taken adhering to the merit list generated through online. After the completion of the online mode of admission an offline mode known as the Spot Round is also conducted for students who for some reasons were not able to secure admission to colleges. In the Academic Year 2021-2022 the college received a huge number of application form for admission since the students were reluctant to join the courses outside the state due to the effect of the Pandemic. In total Women's College had an admission of 1544 students which includes 1185 students in Arts and 358 students in Science. The admission process was completed smoothly with the cooperation of all the teaching and non-teaching staff of the college. The students were also given prompt help with various queries with the college help line committee.

### **STUDENTS' PLACEMENT CELL**

The college managed to conduct sessions for our students virtually in the backdrop of Covid 19. The Students' Placement Cell organized several activities under the leadership of Dr. Somali Saha with a clear objective of motivating and inspiring the students to achieve their career goals. Activities of Students' Placement Cell included virtual lectures by eminent scholars, motivational sessions, personality development programs, soft skill development programs etc. The programs provided platform for the students to enhance their skills such as; leadership, self-confidence, team building, time management as well as effective communication skills. Students' Placement Cell is also involved in imparting skills to the students for making them capable of clearing various competitive examinations. Specific awareness programmes were

conducted for different competitive exams, UGC NET/JRF examinations, IAS/TPS/ TCS exam, etc. The main programmes organized during the academic year are given below.

Students in their own attempt organized a National level webinar on Impact of Covid 19 on Society highlighting various issues related to the pandemic. After this, they organized national level webinars one after another in collaboration with Students' Placement Cell.

### **FACULTY ACHIEVEMENTS**

At present the college has total faculty strength of 54 out of which 19 hold doctoral degrees. Some of the teachers are included in the various academic bodies of universities. The Principal gives utmost priority to the professional development of faculty members. The college encourages teachers to get updated with the new developments and trends in the education sector and the changes occurring in their field of study. A number of teachers acted as resource persons in conferences/ seminars/ workshops organized by other institutions. The faculty members published a good number of research papers in peer reviewed national and international journals. The teachers have been continually participating in various conferences and workshops to broaden their knowledge base.

### **STUDENTS' ACHIEVEMENTS**

It is heartening to mention that 25 students position themselves among the list of University top three in the Undergraduate examinations. Apart from these achievements, students are actively engaged in various co-curricular and extra-curricular activities and bringing accolades for the

college. They are organizing various events time to time, being the active members of cells like Students' Placement Cell, Students' Activity Cell etc.

### **STUDENTS' DIVERSITY AND STUDENTS' PROGRESSION**

The college offers 22 undergraduate programmes, out of which 17 programmes are offering Honours courses. PG Courses will be started in English and Bengali in the Academic session 2022. According to the reservation policy of State Government, 31% seats are allotted to ST and 17% are allotted to SC. We are also having students from the minority class of society. The college has the infrastructure for the specially abled students too. More than 300 students have gone for Higher Education including B. Ed and Post Graduation.

### **STUDENTS' SUPPORT**

The college has always been concerned with the development of the students' intellectual capacity and achievement, emotional make-up, physical condition, social relationships, vocational aptitudes and skills, moral values as well as aesthetic appreciations. The college is providing enough support for the overall development of its students. At the initial level counselling is done to help students deal with a variety of challenges. Mentoring is regularly done to help students overcome barriers such as learning and personal challenges. Tutorial

classes are arranged as per the demands of the students. Students' Placement Cell help students define actionable career goals that align with their personalities and abilities. Students' Council, getting involved with the college authorities help students build confidence, collaborate and develop important skills. The college is providing hostel facility to its students as well as has a good infrastructural facility for the differently abled students.

### **STUDENTS' STIPEND**

Students are offered stipends under the schemes like 'Lower Income Group Scholarship', 'Merit Scholarship', 'Blind Scholarship', 'Girls' Scholarship' as financial support from the institution. Besides, students are also provided with SC scholarship, ST scholarship and OBC scholarship.

### **EXTENSION AND OUTREACH ACTIVITIES**

The college seeks to bring out the best inborn human qualities of the students by sowing the seeds of social responsibility in them through various extension activities. By adopting a neighbouring village 'Indira Colony', NSS Unit of Women's College extends utmost services for the development of the villagers. Relief Services and other welfare activities are conducted in the adopted village time to time. NSS Unit of the college celebrated important days like Road Safety Day, Deworming Day, World Consumer Rights Day, International Women's Day, conducted programme on the Protection of Civil Rights Acts, participated in National Integration Camp and in many more activities. For outstanding contribution in society Women's College bagged the best NSS Program Officer Award in 2021. Not only NSS, but the NCC Cadets also participated in different training activities, parades, webinars, camps, awareness programmes, cleanliness drives, tree plantations etc. NCC cadets performed the duty of traffic control during the Durga Puja festival, participated in security duty during TPS/TCS exams and Armed Forces Flag Day at various locations of Agartala. Two girls bagged Best Cadet Award in 2020-21 and one girl was honoured with the CM award for her outstanding performance from 2019 to 2020.

- ICT will be extensively used in teaching-learning.
- Attempts will be taken to set up Women study centre and women empowerment programme will also be taken up on priority basis.

- Number of computers with better internet facility will be increased to meet the requirement of large number of students
- Initiatives will be taken to develop adequate and proper hostel facilities like mess, safe drinking water etc.
